Mayes County Premium Auction Scholarship Program

Thanks to Dr. Rice and Rogers State University for four, four-year tuition scholarships which will be awarded to four Mayes County seniors. The scholarship is for full tuition, up to 15 hours per semester, and may not be used towards fees or other expenses. The recipient must be enrolled at RSU as a full-time, degree-seeking student and must comply with all Admissions and Financial Aid requirements. The Scholarship is renewable pending fund eligibility. To be considered for renewal the recipient must complete 24 credit hours per academic year and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA.

This year (2025) we will accept applications from students who will enter college next fall as a freshman in 2026.

To be a candidate for the scholarship:

- 1. Must be a full time student.
- 2. Be an active member of a Mayes County 4-H club or FFA chapter.
- 3. Be an exhibitor at the Mayes County Fair in the school year they are applying for the scholarship (not limited to livestock).
- 4. Produce a portfolio to include, but not limited to, applicant information, a transcript, 3 letters of recommendation, and a narrative of an Ag project. (3 copies)

<u>Deadline for entry will be Wednesday, September 3rd.</u> Applications can be turned in at the Mayes County Extension Office. We are tentatively planning the <u>interviews for Sunday</u> <u>afternoon, September 7th.</u>
